How can we as Christians share our bounty with others? Star of the North is partnering with the Edmonton's Inner City Pastoral Ministry and we invite you to meet with members of their ministry team, share a simple meal, and learn more about their ministry.

If Jesus walked the streets of Edmonton today, one of the places he would frequent would be Edmonton's Inner City. Why? Because that's where we find some of the most marginalized and vulnerable people in our community and those are precisely the folks with whom Jesus kept company. Inner City Pastoral Ministry (ICMP) is an ecumenical ministry that has provided a ministry of presence in the inner city for over 30 years. During the week, the pastoral team visits drop in centres, does home and hospital visits, offers Community Memorial Services with the Bissell Elders, provides referrals and simply tries to "be there" with the people as they navigate life's challenges. On the weekend, we provide a worship service and lunch which is brought and served by members of a different church every Sunday of the year. This is one way that Inner City Pastoral Ministry provides a way for folks from the 'burbs' to come to the inner city and meet Christ in the margins and be Christ in the margins.
